Homestyle Chili Competition

First Place: \$300 and Plaque; Second Place: Plaque; Third Place: Plaque; Fourth Place: Plaque; and Fifth

Place: Plaque

Homestyle chili is defined by the International Chili Society as the cook's favorite combination of ingredients resulting in a dish seasoned with chili peppers and spices. The competition places no restrictions on ingredients but the entry must be entirely homemade and have chili pepper flavor. Homestyle chili must be prepared on-site, and pre-cooked meat will not be allowed. For complete details, see the attached rules. The first-place winner advances to the ICS World's Championship Homestyle Chili Cookoff as a North Carolina Homestyle Regional Champion.

Homestyle Chili Cookoff will be held on Friday Night

Homestyle Chili People's Choice Competition Prize: Plaque

Competitors are required to bring with them a minimum of 1 gallon of pre-made homestyle chili. This will be sold by the 4 oz. cup (provided by the N.C. Pickle Festival) beginning at 6:00 PM. The People's Choice Award is given to the competitor who sells the most chili throughout the evening competition, so competitors are encouraged to bring more than the required one gallon. Competitors may also opt to sell the chili they prepare on-site for the homestyle competition once their entry is turned in for judging. NOTE: the pre-made chili is NOT eligible for the homestyle competition.

Homestyle People's Choice Competition will be held on Friday Night

Traditional Red Chili Competition

First Place: \$300 and Plaque; Second Place: Plaque; Third Place: Plaque

Red Chili is defined as any kind of meat or combinations of meats cooked with red chili peppers, various spices and other ingredients with the exception of beans, pasta, or corn, which are strictly forbidden. Judged by panel of selected judges. Red Chili has to be prepared on-site, and pre-cooked meat will not be allowed. For complete details, see attached rules. The First Place will advance to the ICS World's Championship Red Chili as a North Carolina Regional Champion.

Red Chili Cookoff will be held on Saturday

Traditional Red Chili People's Choice Competition Prize: Plaque

Competitors are required to bring with them a minimum of 1 gallon of pre-made Red chili. This will be sold by the 4 oz. cup (provided by the N.C. Pickle Festival) beginning at 9:00 AM. The People's Choice Award is given to the competitor who sells the most chili throughout the day, so competitors are encouraged to bring more than the required one gallon. Competitors may also opt to sell the chili they prepare on-site for the Red Chili competition once their entry is turned in for judging. NOTE: the premade chili is NOT eligible for the Red Chile competition. The People's Choice Red Chili must contain beans, pasta, or corn.

Red Chili People's Choice Competition will be held on Saturday

Salsa Competition Prize: First Place: \$125 and Plaque

Salsa must be homemade. There is no set of ingredients required. It can be made on site or prepared ahead of time.

Salsa Competition will be held on Saturday

Booth Appearance and Showmanship Competition Prize: \$75 and Plaque

Competitors may also compete for the showmanship prize. Extra consideration will be given to those who incorporate the N.C. Pickle Festival and/or Mt. Olive Pickles (and peppers) in their theme. Decorations cannot exceed the 10 x 10 booth space, but there are no limitations in height. No pyrotechnics are allowed. Costumes, music and signs are encouraged. Please assist in our efforts to control litter. No live animals other than service animals are allowed in cooking area.

This will be judged on Saturday only

Judging in all categories will be done by a non-partisan committee whose members are not part of the North Carolina Pickle Festival or ICS.

Competition and Judging	
Competitors must be Homestyle members of the International Chili Society. See the

Competitors for Red Chili and Salsa must be ICS Members. See the application for det	tails.
Homestyle chili and Red Chili must be prepared and cooked on-site based on the published competition schedule. Pre-cooked meat is not allowed.	
Salsa can be prepared ahead of time. Competitors must make a minimum of 32 ounce	es
that is set aside for judging.	
Chili competitors must make a minimum of one gallon on-site, of which 32 ounces m	ust
be set aside for judging.	
Competitors must bring with them a minimum of one gallon of chili and/or salsa made	le in
advance to be used for the People's Choice competitions.	
Competition chili may not be sold in People's Choice until the entry is submitted for j	udging
Judging will be blind taste.	
A minimum of 15 competitors are required for the Homestyle, 15 competitors for Re	d
Chili, and 7 competitors for the Salsa Competition. If we do not receive enough	
competitors for this event, we will proceed with the competition and prizes, but the	!
winner will not be ICS recognized in order to proceed to the World's Championship	
Homestyle, Red Chili, or Salsa Cookoff.	
Setup and Logistics	
Set up begins at 3:00 PM on Friday for Homestyle Chili. Vehicles should be unloaded	
then immediately parked in a designated lot. (Parking is available in the adjacent To	
Hall parking lot, but is available on a first come, first served basis.) Competitors can	then
return to set up their booths. Vehicles must be out of the festival area by 4:00 PM.	
Set up begins at 6:00 AM on Saturday. Vehicles should be unloaded and then	
immediately parked in a designated lot. (Parking is available in the adjacent Town H	
parking lot, but is available on a first come, first served basis.) Competitors can then	
return to set up their booths. Vehicles must be out of the festival area by 7:30 AM.	
Booth spaces are 10 x10 in size, and competitors must provide their own 10 x 10 tent	
everything they will need for the day. This includes tables and chairs, decorations ar	
cooking utensils. Cups, spoons and napkins will be provided by the N.C. Pickle Festiv	al
for the People's Choice competition and chili judging.	
No direct water source is provided. However, a water spigot is available on site.	
No Electricity or Generators will be available.	
Booth assignments will not be changed once made. If you have any special requests,	
please submit them with your application. The NC Pickle Festival does not guarantee	e the
ability to meet every request.	

Sanitation, Cleanliness and Safety
Competitors agree to clean their area of festival grounds at the conclusion of the Chili
Cookoff. This includes the removal of all trash no matter how small.
Competitors must make prior arrangements to transport any used cooking oil away from
festival grounds. If participant is observed disposing of cooking oil on the festival
grounds, the participant will be asked to leave and no refund of fees will be given.
Any gray water must be disposed in the gray water barrels provided. If a participant is
observed disposing of gray water in a storm grate or on the ground, they will be asked
to leave and no refund of fees will be given.
In addition, competitors who violate the above rules can be subject to fines of up to
\$500, and will not be allowed to participate in future N.C. Pickle Festival Chili Cookoff
events.
Competitors must complete the enclosed Town of Mount Olive Fire Protection Permit
and abide by its requirements, including having a dry chemical ABC extinguisher in their
booth and posting a copy of the permit for inspection by fire officials.

You must fulfill these requirements by order of the Mount Olive Fire Inspector in accordance with the North Carolina Fire Prevention Code

- 1. An unobstructed fire access road shall have a width of no less than twenty feet.
- 2. Fire apparatus access roads shall not be obstructed in any manner, including the parking of vehicles
- 3. All vendors shall have a 2-A:10 B:C fire extinguisher (dry chemical ABC extinguisher)
- 4. <u>All vendors using cooking equipment involving grease, vegetable oil or animal oils and fats, shall have both a 2-A:10 B:C portable fire extinguisher.</u>
- 5. All tents, canopies and tarps shall be composed of flame resistant material or shall be treated with a flame retardant in an approved manner and labeled or certified as such.
- 6. All compressed gas containers, cylinders and tanks shall be secured to prevent falling.
